This is not a wellbeing question. It is a **retention and performance** question. The cost you are actually managing is one senior person leaving.

What we put *in writing*, before you sign

- 1 The resident Zen Expert is present every working day, or the contract extends free.
- 2 A usage report reaches you every Friday, unasked, whether the number is rising or not.
- 3 If the room underperforms by week six, it is redesigned at Zariyaa's cost.
- 4 You can end the agreement with 30 days' notice. There is no lock-in.

There are four and there is no fifth. **Every one is about Zariyaa's own conduct**, and every one can only be broken by us. Not one is a promise about how your people will behave, because nobody can honestly make that promise, and a guarantee that cannot be kept is worse than no guarantee at all.

The permanent room

from ₹15,00,000

Sized to your floor. Three zones, a Zen Expert present every working day, and the weekly count.

Try it first. A two-day trial in your own office, ₹2,00,000, confirmed in writing before anything is installed. Your people decide whether it stays, on usage measured on your own floor.

The room is already *waiting*. Start a conversation, then stand in one. Nothing convinces like being in the room.
